Subject: Kino Bay Inc. Selling of Counterfeit Product and Transportation of Same Across State Lines

Dear Ms. Bonner;

Enclosed you will find 2 cease and desist letters one issued to Kino Bay Inc. of Los Angeles, California Mr. Yong Kim its President and the other to Iris Industries Inc. of Hamilton New Jersey Ms. Olga Acevedo its President.

In addition I am submitting copies of revocation of a distribution agreement that Kino Bay had with our company B&A Int'l, Inc issued on February 14, 2008 along with original letter to Mr. Jim Caldwell (United States Environmental Protection Agency) along with a follow-up letter and a letter to the Joint US/Canadian Departments of Defense Certification Office.

We have been informed that Kino Bay Inc. continues to distribute and export a counterfeit facsimile of our product known as FPE Fuel Performance Enhancer which he originally received in February 2008 from Iris Industries Inc. who ordered product from B&A Int'l, Inc. for delivery to the New York Police Department (pricing and delivery terms were given in consideration of product going to a Government Institution) a fraudulent purchase order and only found when I started calling NYPD to inquire about payment delays.

Further Kino Bay Inc. continues to not only sell a counterfeit product as our relationship with Iris Industries was severed and no other product was ever delivered to Iris in direct violation of trade mark rights but they are also using our copyrighted materials and US Government Documents (US EPA Registration Letter and Department of Defense Certification) for advertising purposes on their website www.bestfpe.com.

As advised by the Port of Los Angeles Police Department we are also covering with this letter the following; Department of Customs and Border Protection, U.S. International Trade Commission, Port of Los Angeles Police Department, Department of Homeland Security, Hamilton New Jersey Police Department, and the Collin County, Texas District Attorney's Office.

It is our understanding that trafficking counterfeited goods across state line is a federal offense involving your offices.
